

HEMINGWAY'S STYLE

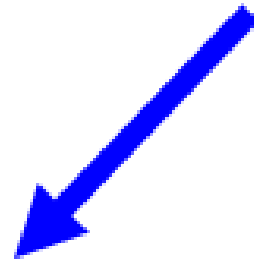
Hemingway played an important role in the **modernisation of American prose style.**

Hemingway's style derived from the years he spent working as a **journalist**: he had a great influence on the following generations of writers.

It's a **plain and hard style**, with vast and **profound silences** and **short, almost monosyllabic exchanges** of the characters.

These features create a **very intense atmosphere** (as we have seen in the short story "**The Killers**").

Thanks to his style, Hemingway creates a lot of **suspense**.
