She **SHOULD** speak to him.

She **SHOULDN'T** speak to him.

(**SHOULD NOT**)



COULD

He **COULD** buy that flat.

HE **COULDN'T** buy that flat.

(**COULD NOT**)



She SHOULD SPEAK to him now.

She SHOULD HAVE SPOKEN
to him two weeks ago!

He COULD BUY that flat now!

He COULD HAVE BOUGHT
that flat last year!

She SHOULD HAVE SPOKEN
to him two weeks ago.

He SHOULDN'T HAVE LEFT her.

He COULD HAVE SOLD his flat.

She COULDN'T HAVE LEFT him.

SHOULD + HAVE + PAST PART.

Shouldn't + HAVE + PAST PART.

COULD + HAVE + PAST PART.

Couldn't + HAVE + PAST PART.

She SHOULD ~~HAS~~ SPOKEN...

She SHOULD HAVE SPOKEN...

*ALWAYS "HAVE"
(NOT "~~HAS~~"!)*

He COULD HAVE BOUGHT it.
